DATA PROTECTION PRINCIPLES

1. Data Controller

- 1.1. Data Controller is State Information System Authority (RIA).

2. Data Processing legal basis and purposes.

- 2.1. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is the consent given by the participants (according to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) article 6 paragraph 1 point a).
- 2.2. During this event, we collect personal data only for the purpose of organizing this event, promoting similar events and providing statistics to the project financier (European Commission).
- 2.3. In addition, we photograph the event, but since it is a public event, data subjects written consent is not necessary. The data subject's consent to the taking of photos in a public place for the purpose of publicizing the photos is replaced by informing the data subjects in a form that allows the data subject to avoid being photographed. Thus, a person can be photographed for the purpose of publicizing photos if the photographing and filming takes place in a public place and the organizer has informed the persons about what is happening. We have added the relevant notification to the event website, registration form and into these data protection principles.

3. Collected Personal Data

- 3.1. The personal data collected includes the participant's name, contact information (e-mail address, phone number), organisation, country, dietary restrictions or allergies, comments, photos and consents.

4. Data Retention

- 4.1. Personal data collected during the event will be published on RIAs website post-event for the participants who have authorized it in the registration form. Personal data collected from the participants who did not authorize the publication of their data will be deleted when their processing purposes are fulfilled. The maximum period of storage of personal data is 5 years. The deadline results from the contract signed with the European Commission and the need to prove the purposes of using the project's funding (audits).

5. Photographer and Recording

- 5.1. Please note that a photographer will be present at the event and the event will be photographed. The photos can be published on social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, YouTube and LinkedIn or RIAs website.

6. Data Subjects Rights

- 6.1. Attendees will have the right to access, rectify, and erase their personal data collected during the event, as well as the right to object to its processing and to withdraw their consent at any time.

7. Data Sharing

- 7.1. Personal data collected during the event will be shared with the co-organizing institutions: National Cybersecurity Coordination Centre of Finland (NCC-FI) and National Cybersecurity Coordination Centre of Sweden (NCC-SE) for the purposes of coordinating this event.
